Plan your commute:

Road closures on Highway 40 and closure of the Turcot interchange

Major construction work in early November will cause important closures and will limit routes to the Montréal-Trudeau airport site. The following information will help you plan your commute.

Highway 40: November 3rd & 4th Weekend

Complete closure of a segment of the A40 between the A13 (exit 60) and boul. St. John (Exit 52) in both directions, including service roads. The exit ramps of the A13 North and South to the A40 West will also be closed during this period.

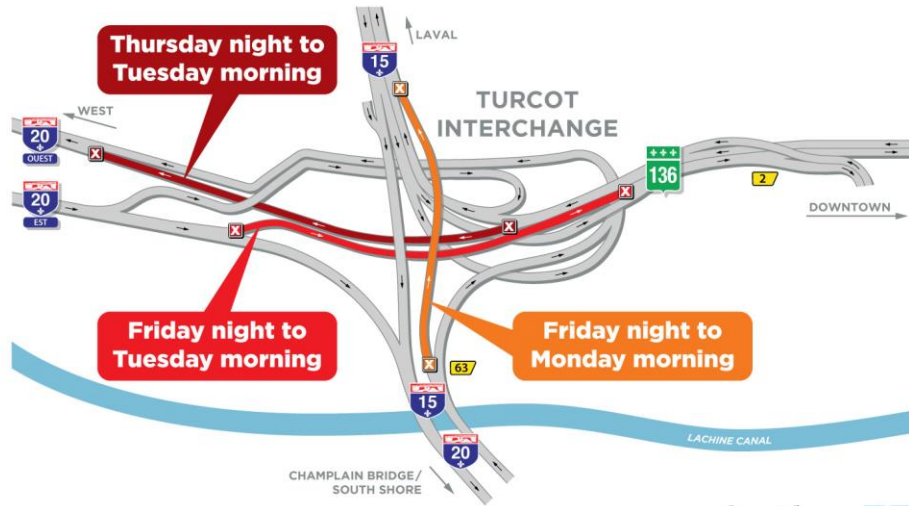
Turcot: Friday, November 9th to Tuesday November 13th

Unprecedented closures will cause very difficult traffic conditions. In the heart of the Turcot interchange:

- Highway 20 westbound, closed from Thursday evening to Tuesday morning
- Highway 20 eastbound, closed from Friday evening to Tuesday morning
- Highway 15 northbound, closed from Friday evening to Monday morning

Some truck restrictions in the neighboring Turcot areas are also planned.
